Women in Golf Charter

The Singapore Golf Association is delighted and proud to support The R&A on the launch of the Women in Golf Charter. Working closely with the Singapore Ladies' Golf Association (SLGA) we strive to encourage female participation and remove barriers of representation.

In the renewed SGA constitution, there must be two ladies from the SLGA to be represented on the Executive Board. The SGA takes on the role to grow High Performance Women's golf while the SLGA focuses on social female participation in the game. Our aim is to have a more joined up approach and avoid duplication of effort.

The SLGA has strengthened since and has been actively organising social events for ladies. They also play an important role in supporting junior development in Singapore; either by volunteering during our junior activities or provide mentorship to our girls.

The SGA pledge to support the Charter through:

- Encouraging more female involvement at every level of Singapore Golf Association
- Maintaining a strong commitment to female leadership and work closely with SLGA
- Continually improving the level of the Equality for Sport through our equality and diversity action plan
- Having a team of Women Representatives in our Tournament, Rules & Administration committees
 - Tournament Directors, Referees, Course Rating officers and Tournament Administrators
- Organising Workshops for Women/Girls to educate them more about the Women's Charter and how they can enjoy the game more
 - Example: 1-Day Workshops on "Women's Golf"
 - Education of the New Rules 2019; USGA Handicapping System (WHS); Health
 Wellness discussions on how to prevent injuries and skincare from the
 sun; Golf Clinics on general fundamentals and short game
 - Helps networking and encourage women in golf to consider exploring various options they can possibly contribute
- Improving performances in World Amateur Golf Rankings

We are committed to achieving our pledge and will continue to work collaboratively with The R&A to encourage a more inclusive culture within golf. The SGA is committed to stay relevant, dynamic and engaging to promote and grow the game.
