# 1. OFFICIAL PRACTICE DAYS

The official practice days are:

Sunday 13 August GANTON 8.00am - 3.00pm Monday 14 August FULFORD 8.00am - 3.00pm

You will be notified of the process to enable you to book practice times in a separate communication. Please do not contact the host venues to try and book official practice times.

<u>Ganton</u>: Any bookings out with the official practice day are at the discretion of the club and will be subject to availability and a green fee of £87.50. Any enquiries must be directed to emmab@gantongolfclub.com

<u>Fulford</u>: Any bookings out with official practice day are at the discretion of the club and will be subject to availability and a green fee of £55.00 (Mon-Thur) / £65.00 (Fri-Sun). Any enquiries must be directed via the club office via info@fulfordgolfclub.co.uk

The practice facilities and clubhouse will not be available to competitors out with the Official Practice Days unless you have paid a visitor green fee.

ONE BALL ONLY MAY BE PLAYED DURING THE PRACTICE ROUNDS WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTION: If a player misses the green with her shot to the green, she may play one additional practice shot. In addition, players must not play from any areas of tees covered by netting.

### 2. PRACTICE FACILITIES

The facilities will be available at your venue from 90 minutes prior to your tee time. The R&A will provide practice balls.

The practice ranges will be operated during the following times.

Competitors may only access the range at the venue they are scheduled to play on that day. Do not attempt to practise at the alternative venue as permission will be denied.

From Thursday onwards, priority access will be given to the players who qualify through each Match Play stage at Ganton. There will be limited practice space for those who have failed to qualify or have been eliminated and it will be allocated on a first come, first served basis with a time limit if necessary

Competitors using any of the practice facilities do so at their own risk.

The R&A is indebted to Titleist for providing practice range balls for the Championship.

PRACTICE BALLS MUST NOT BE REMOVED FROM THE PRACTICE RANGE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. ANY PLAYER FOUND GUILTY OF THIS ACTION MAY BE LIABLE TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION BY THE AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIPS COMMITTEE.

## Travelling by Air

### **Fulford & Ganton**

The nearest airports to the venues are Teeside (60 miles), Humberside (55 miles), Leeds/Bradford (62 miles) and Robin Hood (65 miles).

## **Travelling by Car**

(Please note that due to a lane closure with traffic signals close to the Fulford golf club, the Championship's AA Road signs may direct traffic on an alternative route to Sat Nav).

Ganton is situated close to the A64, the main road between York and Scarborough. It is a 35 minutes' drive on the A64 from York.

## **Travelling by Train**

#### **Fulford**

York is on the East Coast mainline (London-Edinburgh) and offers regular direct services straight into Manchester International Airport.

#### Ganton

There is a regular service from York to nearby Malton, Seamer and Scarborough stations. York is on the East Coast mainline (London-Edinburgh) and offers regular direct services straight into Manchester International Airport.

### **Parking**

Please show the attached priority car park pass when entering the Golf Club Car park. You can show this on your phone to the attendants or print out.

#### 4. REGISTRATION

Registration for the Championship will be processed electronically. A separate registration link will be sent to you before the commencement of the Championship.

You must respond to this link no later than 3.00pm on Monday 14 August. The penalty for failing to do so is disqualification.

Please visit the R&A Championship Pavilion on arrival at Ganton to collect your player gift and Ganton Course Guide.

### 5. DRAW FOR THE QUALIFYING ROUNDS

The draw for the qualifying rounds will be published in advance of the Championship and will be available on The R&A website, www.randa.org.

Please note that it is the responsibility of the competitor to ascertain their tee time.

### 6. QUALIFYING PLACES

The 64 lowest scores over the 36 holes will compete in the match play stage. There will be no preliminary round and all places will be determined by card countback as required.

### 7. MATCH PLAY STAGES

The match play draw will be seeded.

During the match play stages, it will be the responsibility of the winner of a match to return a match result

card to the Championship Office or an R&A Rules Official on the course as soon as possible after the match is completed.

No play is permitted after the completion of a match.

#### 8. PLAYER SERVICES

#### **Medical Services**

The Medical Office is located in the Championship Pavilion. If you require urgent assistance, please speak with any R&A official. First aid support is available on the course and can be summoned by speaking with a Rules Official or a scoring volunteer.

### Player Gym

A gym is available in the Championship Pavilion for you to use before or after play.

It will be open from 90 minutes before the first tee time each day.

It will close at 7.00pm, Sunday – Thursday and 6.00pm on Friday.

A strength and conditioning specialist will be there to assist you and they will be happy to help with any queries you may have.

### Water Fountains At The Championship

The R&A supports sustainable practices which go hand in hand with protecting the future of our planet. On course water fountain stations will be available for all players to use throughout the Championship. Please Bring Your Own Refillable Water Bottle.

### Clubhouse & Catering

The clubhouses will be open with catering available from 90 minutes before the first tee time until the last game finishes each day.

During the Matchplay stages only, the starter will issue you with a complimentary lunch voucher. Should you have any allergies please contact the club catering team now.

### 9. SCORE INPUT / LIVE SCORING

Competitors will be issued with a link which will allow them to input scores directly from their personal mobile device. A volunteer scorer will also be positioned after every 3 holes to assist.

#### 10. PACE OF PLAY (Rule 5.6)

It is the responsibility of each competitor to understand the Pace of Play policy. Failure to comply with the Pace of Play policy may result in you being penalised. With this in mind, you are asked to read carefully the Pace of Play policy which is on the player portal.

It is the responsibility of each group to play within the published maximum times allowed (as defined on the noticeboards, portal and on the hole position charts) and keep up with the group in front. In an effort to eradicate slow play, players may also be subject to random timing even when not out of position.

Players are also strongly encouraged to play 'Ready Golf' during the stroke play qualifying stage of the Championship.

Should you have any questions regarding the Pace of Play policy then please visit the Championship Office at any of the venues where R&A Officials will be happy to assist your query.

### 11. CLUB LENGTH

Model Local Rule G-10 in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf is in effect. In making a stroke, the player must not use a club, except for a putter, which exceeds 46 inches in length.

### 12. DRIVING CLUB CONDITION & GROOVES & PUNCH MARKS

The Model Local Rules in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf are in effect regarding <u>Conforming Driver Heads</u>, <u>Conforming Golf Balls</u> and <u>Groove and Punch Mark Specifications</u>.

### 13. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES (RULE 4.3)

A competitor may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only – see Rule 4.3a(1) in the Rules of Golf.

### 15. ANTI-DOPING

As referenced in the Terms of Competition, The R&A has adopted the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping Policy for this Championship. Accordingly, all competitors are subject to the provisions of the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping Policy and may be subject to drug testing conducted in accordance with that Policy. Details of the Policy, and the Prohibited Substances and Methods, are available from the International Golf Federation's website (<a href="www.igfgolf.org">www.igfgolf.org</a>).

Competitors who are taking medication and in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from R&A Championships Limited not later than 30 days before the start of the Championship.

# 16. <u>CADDIES / TROLLEY HIRE</u>

Caddies are not permitted as per the Terms of Competition.

Complimentary sanitised pull trolleys will be available for competitor's courtesy of The R&A.

At each venue, a small supply of electric trolleys is available at a cost to the Competitor. Please contact the venues to reserve one if available.

### 17. COMPETITORS' LOCKER ROOM

The locker room can be accessed to store belongings, to change or to shower. Players may prefer to arrive in golf attire and to change their footwear at their vehicle. Only competitors may access this area and the use of mobile phones in the locker rooms is prohibited.

### 18. <u>WITHDRAWALS</u>
