The ASG is pleased to sign and support the Women in Golf Charter led by the R&A and is proud to have already in place the following:

- Board Members: one woman in the ASG Board Member
- General Secretary: a woman is ASG General Secretary
- ASG Commissions: at least one woman is member in each of our Commissions
- Golf4Girls: in 2017 we started a programme aimed to motivate more girls between the age of 7 to 12 to play and stay in the game. The programme is organized and run by female professionals and female amateur coaches.

We will commit to:

- 1. Actively increase the involvement of women in the ASG Governance and structures.
- 2. Continuing to improve the program Golf4Girls.
- 3. Actively support clubs in modernizing their Governance to improve gender balance and inclusiveness across boards, committees, workforce and membership.
- 4. Increase the number of women playing the game by developing Women & Girls focused initiatives.
- 5. Showcasing Women and Girls as role models throughout every aspect of the game.
